FIRE CODE:

Food vendors are not authorized to cook directly under tents per Fire Code. Each food vendor will be inspected by the local fire department to ensure fire extinguishers are serviceable. Food vendors **WILL NOT** dump gray water or grease onsite. Vendors will be fined by the city if found disposing gray water or grease on the ground and will be asked to leave event.

HEALTH DEPARTMENT:

Each food vendor is responsible in submitting a Temporary Food Permit Application with Pinal County Health Department minimum 2 weeks prior to event. Application is \$25. Inspection will be done onsite.

ON SITE REQUIREMENTS

- Load in on Friday TBD – more updates to come
- Open by 12:00 PM on Saturday and remain open until 9:30 PM
- Tear down may commence Saturday after 9:30 PM. Vendors will be responsible for any damage caused to Peart Park during the event, set-up and/or tear down. It is the vendor's responsibility to clean their booth space prior to leaving the event.
- All business participating in the event is required to check-in at the Event Registration tent prior to setup.
- All vehicles must be off grounds 1 hour prior to gates opening.

ON-SITE SAFETY & SECURITY

- City of Casa Grande and “Ride for The Warrior” is not responsible for damage, theft, or loss of equipment or display furnishings.
- **Event Cancellation:** This event will be rain or shine.
- Event participating businesses must obey all pertinent safety codes and laws, including but not limited to, fire, safety and parking regulations.
- Overnight security will be onsite for Friday night only.
- Canopies must be fire retardant. All canopies, tents and other temporary structures must be weighted before you are permitted to open.
